


Theme E: Improving Accessibility	<p>Gosport does not cater for residents or tourists who drive large motorhomes and parking in the town centre is not possible. This needs to be addressed in the plan. Provision of parking facilities for larger vehicles would encourage more people to visit and spend money in the town. The majority of motorhome owners are retired with disposable income available, but are forced to spend it elsewhere where parking is provided. We are very close to the channel port but we never see foreign motorhomes in Gosport so our businesses are losing out. Our European neighbouring countries positively encourage us as motorhome owners to stay and spend in their towns by providing parking and sometimes emptying facilities and a water tap. In my opinion the reason the car parks may be underused is down to the introduction of parking charges. Gosport does not have a sufficient range of shops to justify spending on parking given the wider choice available in Fareham. Nothing will improve much until the A32 / Newgate Lane congestion is resolved. Locals have to put with it but tourists are put off visiting.</p>
