## **Community Infrastructure Levy: Gosport Draft Charging Schedule**

## Statement on Issues and Questions

Question 1: Taking into account the limited evidence of nonresidential development transactions within the Borough, are the conclusions reached on Existing Site Values for retail warehouses and supermarkets justified?

Date: 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2015



- 1. For the reasons set out in Viability Addendum Report- (paragraph 11.4.1 Document CIL- 6) Adams Integra [AI] considers that the Existing Site Values used for assessing the viability of retail warehouses and supermarkets are justified and sound. There were 2 responses on this category of use following the Draft Charging Schedule consultation. CIL Rep 5 from Thomas Eggar on behalf of Asda Stores did not challenge the Existing Site Values used. In CIL Rep 11, Barton Wilmore on behalf of Milngate challenged the Existing Site Values within all of the appraisals used by AI stating that the conclusions reached 'were not justified and thus not sound'.
- 2. For the reasons stated at 11.4.1 in CIL 6, AI considers that there is no other suitable alternative method of reaching a locally relevant Existing Site Value other than that used. In the absence of appropriate and available evidence of local transactions, the method used is considered robust and justified.
- 3. Al also draws attention to the comments from the Examination of Winchester City Council's Draft Charging Schedule where the Examiner shared Al's views that 'in a slow market where there are few comparable transactions, such a notional development is a reasonable and robust approximation of the middle ground. Subject to sufficient margins being allowed to accommodate the spectrum of development permutations, I consider the approach reasonable'1.
- 4. In the absence of any more suitable evidence from any consultees, Al considers that the evidence has allowed sufficient margins to ensure that the proposed CIL level would not put development at risk.
