The Local Plan will set the strategic framework for the growth and development of Gosport forming the central part of the Borough's Local Development Framework (LDF). The LDF will promote, guide and manage the future development of Gosport and make important choices about how and where new development and regeneration will take place. The LDF will shape the investment plans of the Council and other public, voluntary and private sector organisations and will act as a delivery strategy for the Sustainable Community Strategy (SCS).

The Local Plan will contain policies relating to:

- The scale of new housing, employment and retail development
- The areas which will undergo strategic regeneration
- The design and sustainability of new development
- Environment, waste and resources management
- Transport and other new infrastructure

The Local Plan is a statutory requirement and has to take account of the Council's Strategies that may have land use implications. Its main objective is to provide a planning policy framework against which future development can be assessed.
