#### Action

#### 1 Review of Brief

DH asked if any further background information was available to support the study.

DD handed over the Hampshire TRANSPOL 2004 survey results for Gosport containing detailed transport information at household level, based on travel diaries and user perceptions. LD offered the questionnaire and results from the 2004 pilot commuting survey. CP stated that the LDF Issues & Options and Baseline Report were both available online to provide historic employment data and context. SF offered to send a McKinner telephone survey carried out with business leaders.

TC confirmed that traffic data collection associated with Daedalus would shortly be available, and will check with SEEDA whether that can be shared with this project.

DH will contact Portsmouth City Council to obtain ferry passenger data from mode split survey. LD / SF to obtain and pass on passenger data from Gosport Ferry Company.

LD confirmed that the main priority for the study is to gain a greater understanding of out-commuting patterns / employment, and the requirements of the brief have not changed.

Publicity and awareness raising of the surveys was discussed. Surveys / letters to households and businesses should be branded with GBC & Impact publicity (LD / SF to send logos). Press release to coincide with survey mail-out to be co-ordinated by Impact.

MVA will draft a covering letter to households for approval by GBC (signed by CEO).

## 2 Methodology

### Household Survey

DH circulated a first draft questionnaire for discussion. A lengthy discussion followed, during which the following points were noted:

- Survey will commence with Household information;
- Employment Details
  - To include 'self-employed'
  - Work at home = 'home based employment'
  - Business sector to follow ABI designations
- Home to Work Travel, to include
  - main routes used
  - tick box for 'school run' linked trips
  - 'how do you reach ferry?'
  - What time do you leave work
- Barriers and Incentives section to consider 'influence of transport factors in home / job location decision' and 'perceptions of alternative modes'. Tick boxes to include 'quality of life', 'family commitments', 'access to work', 'house prices' etc,
- Personal Details:
  - motorbike availability (household)
  - skills info collected through 'occupation' rather than qualifications

A space for name & contact details will be available for those wishing to enter the prize draw. LD to send through 'equal opportunities / language' text. LD

LD stated that Gosport Ferry Company wished to collect a range of information from passengers. It was agreed that most of their requirements will be accommodated within the survey, but they were particularly interested in why people choose / do not choose the ferry. This info will not be picked up by household survey, so could be supplemented by GFC survey. GFC agreed to distribute questionnaires on the ferry – this will not upset sample size.

KJ explained the survey distribution and return process. Once approved, questionnaire will be sent to mailing house for printing, collation and distribution. Mail-out is provisionally planned for end May / early June with a 3 week response period. The 'doormat' date can be planned within 2/3 days accuracy, to coincide with other publicity if required.

Should the response rate be lower than expected, a decision on whether to send reminders can be taken approx 2 weeks after initial mail-out. TC commented that going out to a new sample is likely to be preferable to reminder letters.

Survey responses will be sent to an MVA FREEPOST address. Additionally, it will be available online, hosted by MVA but accessed through the GBC website.

Questionnaire will be almost identical for household and business surveys, the only difference being in the 'barriers & incentives' section. MVA to prepare draft questionnaire for approval. KJ

**Business Survey**

DH requested further information on largest employers in Gosport, and clarified that main criteria for employers was those with a probable large number of in-commuters. LD noted that some key employers were not on the draft list in the proposal including HMS Sultan, Quinetic (DRA Haslar), Haslar Hospital & RNAD Frater. Retailers were not represented, but probably employed mainly Gosport residents. LD to provide further information & contacts.

It was agreed that LD or SF would make initial contact with selected companies, and accompany KJ or DH on a visit to each company to explain purpose of the survey and agree the distribution / timing of questionnaires. The meeting was also an opportunity to note anecdotal transport issues from an organisational / operational perspective. TC requested that meetings should be grouped together wherever possible.

In the morning peak period five start times are proposed; 7am, 7.30, 8, 8.30 & 9, commencing in Gosport or Portsmouth TC, or Brockhurst. In the evening peak period five start times 4, 4.30, 5, 5.30, 6pm.

DD / LD are in discussion with HCC (Tim Barton) regarding possible expansion of JT surveys. TC suggested that JTS runs to the heart of the proposed Fareham SDA would provide useful information. Also, by repeating the surveys tabulated above on a second day, the results would be more robust. For example this could provide two runs for each start time.

DD requested that journey time routes commence from Brockhurst roundabouts, rather than Hardway / Rowner. A Lee on Solent route was also discussed as a possible extra to the survey.
