<p>Hampshire County Council (HCC) as Highway Authority made the following representation on the Gosport Borough Council draft Local Plan in February 2013: <i>“An additional paragraph is required to explain how developer contributions for transport infrastructure will be gathered using the Highway Authority’s Transport Contribution Policy until CIL is adopted. The text of such a paragraph could be as follows:</i></p> <p><u><i>Until CIL is adopted transport Infrastructure will continue to be funded by developers in accordance with the Highway Authority’s Transport Contribution Policy.”</i></u></p> <p>This recommendation by the Highway Authority about the Transport Contribution policy until the adoption of CIL does not appear to have been included in the Publication version of the Local Plan. However The Highway Authority is of the opinion that there should be wording in the Publication Local Plan to reflect this scenario before CIL is adopted and in operation by Gosport Borough Council, which is likely to be 2015.</p>

<p>Hampshire County Council as Highway Authority requests that the Borough Council adds the following paragraph to the associated text on Infrastructure to support Policy LP2 which explains how developer contributions for transport infrastructure will be gathered using the Highway Authority’s Transport Contribution Policy until CIL is adopted:</p> <p><u><i>Until CIL is adopted transport infrastructure will continue to be funded by developers in accordance with the Highway Authority’s Transport Contribution Policy.”</i></u></p>
