Effective - the plan should be deliverable over its period and based on effective joint working on cross boundary strategic priorities; and

Consistent with National policy - the plan should enable the delivery of sustainable development in accordance with the policies in the Framework.

As currently worded, the policy fails to be specific enough to be considered ed by being consistent with the evidence base. The Council's Gosport Retail Study rtaken by GVA (2014) does not identify any capacity for additional convenience floorspace the plan period. As such, in order to prevent any retail development which could potentially existing defined centres, the Policy should go further and specifically confirm that 'small ' means a maximum of 300sqm gross. This will ensure that any convenience floorspace nly serve the day to day needs of the site and immediate catchment area and not nentally impact on existing town centre foodstore, some of which have been identified in s study as undertrading.
