## Affordable housing performance 2009-2014

## Policy R/H states:

The Borough Council will seek the provision of 40% affordable housing on suitable sites where proposals for residential development are either 0.5 hectares or more on area or 15 dwellings or more in total.

In practice, the Borough Council has also achieved the provision of 40% affordable housing for residential development on most sites of at least 0.5 hectare or 15 dwellings or more in total. The provision of affordable housing has dropped off over recent years due to the current economic downturn.

Regular monitoring of housing completions is documented in the Borough Council's Annual Monitoring Reports these are available on the Borough Council's website at: <a href="www.gosport.gov.uk/annual-monitoring-report">www.gosport.gov.uk/annual-monitoring-report</a> has shown Gosport delivering a high rate of housing completions and has been ahead of meeting the target in the local plan of 2,500 dwellings between 2006 and 2026.

However, as a result of the economic downturn of recent years, there has been a reduction in the number of residential completions.
