Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029

Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning Regulation (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 as (amended) notice is hereby given that Gosport Borough Council adopted the Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029 on 14th October 2015.

Inspector John Wilde CEng MICE, appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, undertook an examination of the Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029 which included a public hearing session in March 2015. The Inspector's report issued on 7th September 2015 concluded that the Local Plan is sound and legally compliant subject the Inspector's main modifications pursuant to Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. The Adopted version of the Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029 incorporates all of the main modifications set out in Appendix 1 of the Inspector's report.

The Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029 covers the administrative area of Gosport Borough Council and replaces the Gosport Borough Local Plan Review 2006.

Any person aggrieved by the Gosport Borough Local Plan 2011-2029, October 2015 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the plan is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than 11.59pm on 24th November 2015 (6 weeks after the date of adoption specified above).
