Painted stucco walling, with parapet and cornice, cambered first floor window eads on either side of central round arched recess (formerly with inn sign). Ground loor is a slightly projecting 'frame' with cornice, frieze led into pilasters, ambered window openings with recessed treatment, plinth, and recessed central doorway.
