

Policy context	The land is allocated for mixed use regeneration under Policy LP6 of the Local Plan. The site is also allocated in the draft GBLP 2038. The land is within a conservation area and contains a Scheduled Ancient Monument as well as a Grade II listed building. The land is also within Flood Zone 2 and 3 and potentially contaminated.
Planning status	None
Deliverable	Development is expected within ten years.
Site size	17.90 ha
Housing range	Approximately 475 dwellings – subject to further work and ongoing masterplan work by the site promoter as part of the Local Plan review.
Non-residential	Marine-led employment and leisure to take advantage of the deep water access, marine infrastructure, sail training facilities, maritime heritage assets and existing museum, and proximity to the mouth of Portsmouth Harbour and the Solent.
Comments	The MoD is expected to release the site in the next three years.
