

Concluding comments	The site area was assessed as unable to accommodate 5 dwellings. As a result the site is unsuitable for the SHLAA. The sites awkward shape and small size makes it difficult to achieve housing on the site. The council have in recent years built new garages on the site making it highly unlikely the site would be available for disposal. Any development would have to address potential access constraints, overlooking and neighbouring amenity and land ownership.
