

Concluding comments	The site is a relatively thin strip of land between existing dwellings and the road. Development would base within close proximity to these existing dwellings and likely result in a reduce quality of life for residents. It is considered that this site forms an attractive feature in the streetscene and should be retained as an amenity area. Given the access and amenity constraints the site has been assessed as unable to accommodate 5 or more dwellings. As such the site is unsuitable for inclusion in the SHLAA.
