TITLE:	COUNCIL TAX SETTING 2009/10

PURPOSE OF REPORT

The report consolidates the effect of the Council's approved budget, Collection Fund surplus and precepting authority requirements in order to establish the necessary council tax levels to apply in the Borough of Gosport for 2009/2010.

RECOMMENDATIONS

As contained in section 5 of the report.

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Council are required to set the levels of Council Tax for the Borough for 2009/2010 on behalf of the Council as billing authority. The tax level results from the precept requirements of Hampshire's County Council, Police Authority and Fire & Rescue Authority, the Council's approved budget and local tax collection balances.
- 1.2 No comments relating to the budget level have yet been received as a result of the statutory consultation process with major business ratepayers.

2.0 COLLECTION FUND SURPLUSES & DEFICITS

2.1 Surpluses or deficits from Council Tax collection are assessed annually in order that corrective action can be taken in setting future Tax levels. They form part of the figure contained in recommendation 5.2(d). The figure of £100,000 represents Gosport's share of surpluses on the council tax collection fund as considered as part of the approved Budget.

2.2 The table below shows how these balances affect the Council Tax requirements:

The 2009/2010 total figures represent an increase of 2.36% over 2008/2009, Gosport's element having increased by 2.5%

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1 That it be noted that the Borough Treasurer determined the Council's Tax Base on 09 January 2009 in the amount of 27,670.7 as its Council Tax Base for the year 2009/2010 in accordance with Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities (Calculation of Council Tax Base) Regulations 1992 made under Section 33(5) of the Local Government Finance Act 1992, as amended by Section 84 of the Local Government Act 2003.
- 5.2 By virtue of the budget approved by Council on the 04 February 2009 the following amounts be now calculated by the Council for the year 2009/2010 in accordance with Sections 32 to 36 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992:-
- (a) £52,909,590 being the aggregate of the amounts which the Council estimates for the items set out in Section 32(2)(a) to (e) of the Act.
 - (b) £39,937,590 being the aggregate of the amounts which the Council estimates for the items set out in Section 32(3)(a) to (c) of the Act.
 - (c) £12,972,000 being the amount by which the aggregate at 5.2(a) above exceeds the aggregate at 5.2(b) above, calculated by the Council, in accordance with Section 32(4) of the Act, as its budget requirement for the year.
 - (d) £7,360,152 being the aggregate of the sums which the Council estimates will be payable for the year into its general fund in respect of redistributed non-domestic rates, revenue support grant and additional grant; increased by the amount of the sums which it estimates will be transferred in the year from its collection fund to its general fund in accordance with Section 97(3) of the Local Government Finance Act 1988 (Council Tax Surplus).
 - (e) £202.81 being the amount at 5.2(c) above less the amount at 5.2(d) above, all divided by the amount at 5.1(a) above, calculated by the Council, in accordance with Section 33(1) of the Act, as the basic amount of its council tax for the year.

- 5.3 That it be noted that for the year 2009/2010 Hampshire County Council, Hampshire Police Authority and Hampshire Fire Authority have stated the following amounts in precepts issued to the Council, in accordance with Section 40 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992, for each of the categories of the dwellings shown below:-
