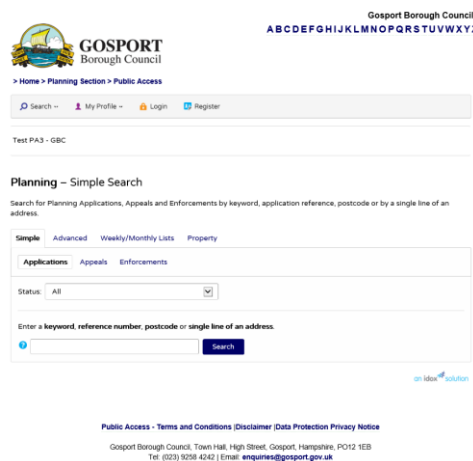




This user guide has been produced to help you get the best out of the Public Access system on Gosport Borough Council's website to view and track applications for planning permission.

You can find details of planning applications from 1948 to the present day. The older applications show only a few details, such as the proposal and decision date, but the more recent applications will show as much detail as possible, including copies of the planning documents used in the process.

To get onto Public Access just click the following link or paste it into your browser address bar: <https://publicaccess.gosport.gov.uk> and it will show the page below:



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Registration

Anyone can use the IDOX Public Access for Planning site to view planning applications WITHOUT having to register. However to take advantage of the advanced profile features that allow you to save searches and track applications you must first register a user account.

1. To create a new user account click on Register in the menu bar, so the following page appears.

Once registered the following additional functionality will be available:

- Tracking applications
- Saving Searches
- Email notifications about tracked applications and new search results.

2. Complete all the asterisk marked fields with your details:

- **Title** – select the title you wish to be addressed by.
- **First Name** – enter your first name.
- **Surname** – enter your surname.
- **Email Address** – enter your email address. Enter it again to confirm that it is correct.
- **Password** – enter a password that will allow only you to access your account. Repeat it in the box below.

Note: Passwords must be at least eight characters or longer and be a mix of letters and numbers and may not contain spaces. Enter the password again below to confirm that it is correct.



3. Click on **Next**.
4. Enter your **Postcode**, then press Next.
5. Select your address from the drop down list if listed, then click on **Next**. If your address is not listed, select **My address is not on the list** and click on **Next**. Or if your postcode is not found in the Council's database you will be prompted to enter your full address.
6. Enter your address details in the appropriate fields, then click on **Next**.

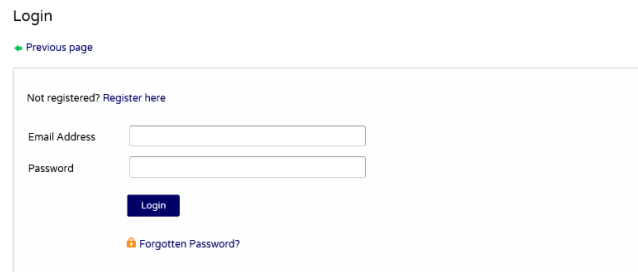
7. Click to read the **Terms and Conditions** that apply to the use of this site. When you have done so, tick the check box to indicate that you agree to them.
8. Read the **Your Data** section to understand what personal data Public Access uses and why. When you have done so, tick the check box to indicate that you agree to them.
9. Check that your personal and login details are correct. To register them click on the **Next** button.
10. An email will be sent to the address you registered. This allows you to confirm that you want to create an IDOX Public Access for Planning account. When the email arrives, click on the link to be returned to the IDOX Public Access for Planning site.



Log in

In order to use the full range of features offered by IDOX Public Access For Planning, such as saving searches, you need to log into the site using the user name and password you provided when you registered your account.

1. Click on **Login** button in the menu bar, so the following page appears.

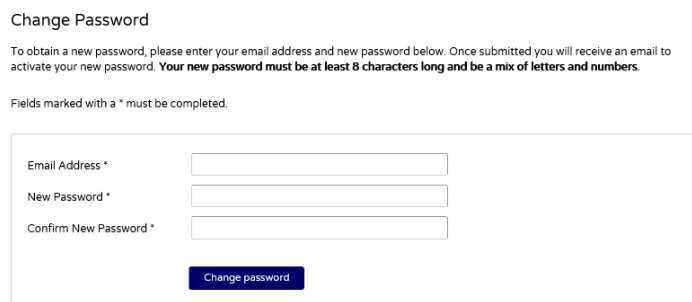

2. Enter your user name and password, then click on the **Login** button.
3. If you registered prior to the Public Access 3.1 release, you may be asked to read the new Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy that apply to the use of the site. When you have done so, tick the check box to indicate that you agree to them.

Forgotten Password

1. If you forget your password, once on the Login screen click on the **Forgotten password?** link.
2. Enter your email address and then enter a new password twice. Press the **Change password** button.

Logout

When you have finished using IDOX Public Access for Planning, you can log out of the system by clicking on the **Logout** button in the menu bar.

My Profile

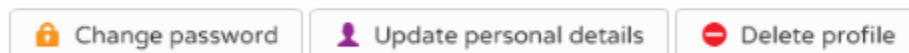
Once you have logged into your account you can access your My Profile area. This area allows you to update your personal details as well as manage your searches, notified and tracked applications.

- **Profile Details** – your registered personal details
- **Saved Searches** – a list of searches which you have saved
- **Notified Applications** – notifications that applications that you are tracking, or are the subject of saved searches, have been modified
- **Tracked Applications** – a list of applications that you have selected to track.

Profile Details

The Profile Details page allows you to update any of your personal details and password that you provided when you registered. The Profile Details page also allows you to view how your data is used by Public Access. You can also delete your account on this page if you no longer require this service.

1. To access your profile page select **Profile Details** from the My Profile drop down list in the menu bar.
2. The page will display the details you registered with. You can change any of those details or update your password.



3. To update your password click on **Change password**.



4. Enter your email address and then enter a new password twice. Press the **Change password** button.
5. A confirmation email will be sent to your email address. When it arrives, click on the confirmation link. You will now be able to log in with your new password.
6. To change your details click on **Update Personal Details**. The pages will take the same form as when you first registered. Alter your details as appropriate, clicking on the **Next** button to page through the sections.
7. To delete your account click **Delete Profile**. You will be asked to confirm that you want to delete your account. If you wish to proceed press Delete. Your account will now be removed from the system.

Clicking 'Delete' will delete all of your profile and registration information. No personally identifiable information will be retained by the system.

Saved Searches

To find planning case details on IDOX Public Access for Planning site you must perform a search (see Searching). If you find that you frequently perform the same search you can save the search so that they may be repeated easily as often as you like.

Any changes to the status of applications previously found by your search criteria or any new applications which match the criteria of a saved search will trigger a notification. These notifications are listed in the Notified Applications page.

1. To view your saved searches, select **Saved Searches** from the My Profile drop down list.

2. You can sort the list by clicking on the appropriate column headings:
 - **Search Title** – sort the list alphanumerically by search title
 - **Search Type** – sort the list alphabetically by search type.



3. To perform a saved search now, click on the **Run** button for that search.
4. To modify the search criteria, click on the **Edit** button for that search. Enter the new details you wish to search for and then press Save.
5. To remove a search from the list, click on the **Delete** button for that search.

Notified Applications

If you selected to be notified of modifications to applications that are returned from your saved search or are in your Tracked Applications list, a list of the modified applications will appear in the Notified Applications page. You will also be sent a notification email.

1. To view your notifications, select **Notified Applications** from the My Profile drop down list.
2. The tracked applications that have been modified are listed at the top of the screen. These are followed by the modified applications that are subject to your saved searches.
3. To view a case, click on the **View** button for that case.
4. To remove a case from the notifications list, click on the **Discard** button for that case. To delete all of the notified results for a particular search, click on **Discard all results from this search**.
5. If you want to track a case that was returned from a saved search click on the **Track** button beside the applications of interest. It will now be added to your Tracked Applications page.



Tracked Applications

If you find a current planning application of interest that you want to keep updated on you can choose to keep a watch on it by tracking it.

Applications that you have selected to track are displayed on the **Tracked Applications** page. When a tracked application is modified a notification will appear on the Notified Applications page and you will be sent a notification email.



1. To view your tracked applications, select **Tracked Applications** from the My Profile drop down list.

2. You can sort the list by clicking on the appropriate column headings:
 - **Reference** – sort the list alphanumerically by its case number
 - **Address** – sort the list alphanumerically by the address that is the subject of the case
 - **Type** – sort the list alphabetically by the case type
 - **Status** – sort the list alphabetically by the status of the case.
3. To view a tracked case, click on the **View** button for that case.
4. To remove an application from the tracked applications list, click on the **Stop Tracking** button for that application. You will be asked to confirm that you want to stop tracking the application. If you wish to proceed press Delete. The application will now be removed from the list.

Searching

To find planning application, appeal or enforcement notices details on the Public Access for Planning site you must perform a search. Public Access provides a variety of methods to allow you to find the information you are looking for using the details you know:

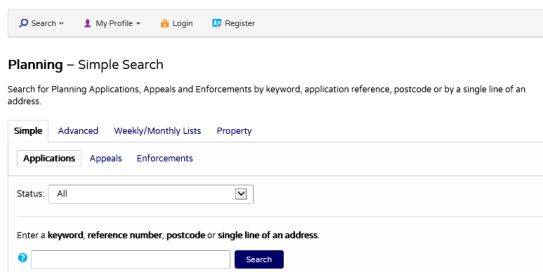
- **Simple search** – search for applications using the reference number, address or key word.
- **Advanced search** – this search allows you to use a wide combination of factors, such as dates, status and alternative reference numbers.
- **Property search** – search for applications related to a particular address
- **Weekly/monthly lists** – search for applications which where validated or decided within a particular week/month.



Simple Search

A simple search allows you to search quickly for a planning application by entering some key details that identify it, for example the reference number or postcode.

1. Select **Simple Search** from the Search Planning drop down list.

2. Select the type of case you wish to search, Applications, Appeals or Enforcement.
3. If you choose to search for Applications, you can also select the status of the records you are looking for: Current, Decided or All applications. Choose the appropriate option from the Status drop down list.
4. Enter one of the following details in the in the Search box:-
 - **application reference number** (for example, 12/00170/FULL)
 - **post code** (for example, "PO12 1EB")
 - **part of an address** (for example, "High Street" or "Town Hall")
 - **keyword from proposal** (for example "RENDER" or "DEMOLISH").
5. Click on the **Search** button to display the results of your search. If your search returns only one application you will be taken to the application details page. If your search returns multiple applications you will be shown the list of results, as below.

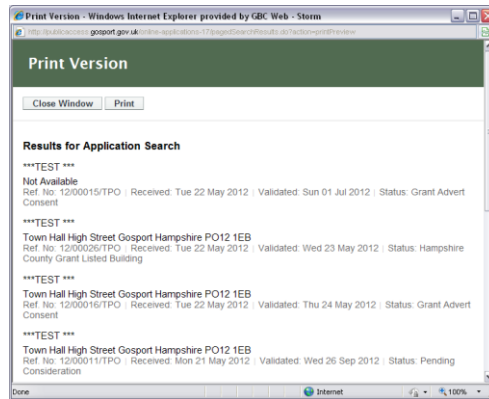

11. To display the current page of search results in a printable format, click on the **Print** button. A new window should open with the results in a list. Click on the **Print** button in the new window to send the page to your local printer. Press **Close Window** when you are finished with this window.



Advanced Search

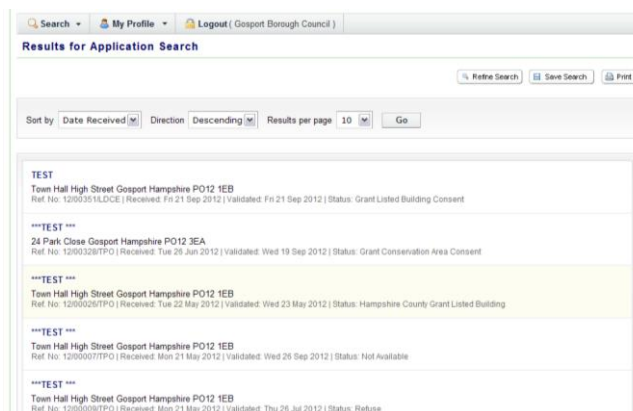
An advanced search allows you to search for planning applications using alternative reference numbers, dates and other application details. It also allows you to build a complex combination of specific criteria on which to search for an application.

1. Select **Advanced Search** from the Search Planning drop down list.



2. Select the type of case you wish to search, Applications, Appeals or Enforcement.
3. If you know a reference number that identifies a specific application enter it in the appropriate box.
4. The details section allow you to specify an application type, status or decision as well as location details, which include ward and address information. Enter any combination of these details as appropriate.
5. If you want to search within a specific date range then you can use any combination of the Dates fields to enter the required range when the case was lodged or decided.
6. Once you have selected your required search criteria click on the **Search** button to display the results of your search. If your search returns only one application you will be taken to the application details page. If your search returns multiple applications you will be shown the list of results, as below.



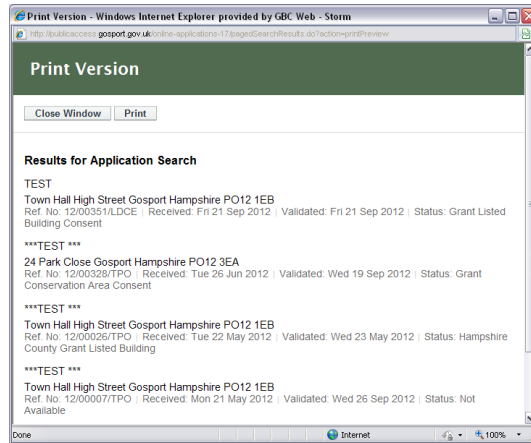

Property Search

The Property Search feature allows you to search for a specific property. There are two options:

- **A to Z Street Search** – search for applications on a specified street chosen from an alphabetical list
- **Address Search** – search for applications at a specified address.

A to Z Street Search

1. Select **Property Search** from the Search drop down list.
2. To search for a street alphabetically, select the **A to Z Street Search** tab.

3. Click on the initial letter of the street you are interested in.
 - If there a large number of streets beginning with the selected letter you can navigate between the results pages either by clicking on **Next** to view the next page or by clicking directly on the page number displayed just above and below the search results.
 - To change the number of results displayed, select from the **Results per page** drop down list, followed by **Go**.
4. Select the required street from the list to display the addresses on that street.
 - To change the direction of the list select Ascending or Descending from the **Direction** drop down list, followed by **Go**.
 - If there a large number of properties in the selected street you can navigate between the results pages either by clicking on **Next** to view the next page or by clicking directly on the page number displayed just above and below the search results.
 - To change the number of results displayed, select from the **Results per page** drop down list, followed by **Go**.

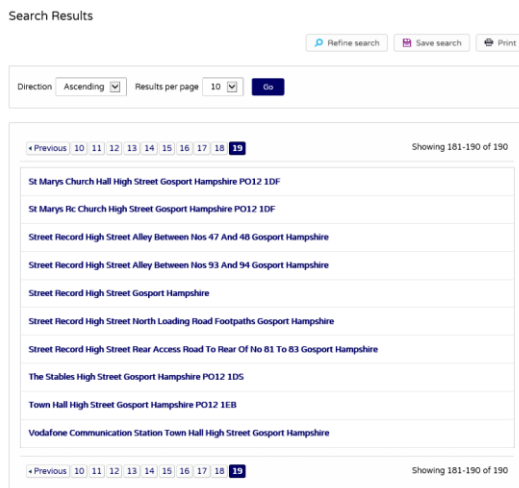

1. Select **Weekly/Monthly Lists** from the Search drop down list tab.

2. Click on **Weekly List** or **Monthly List** to select which list you want to search.

3. Select the whether you want to view Decided or Validated applications by clicking the required **Show applications** field.

4. Specify the desired **Week** or **Month** by selecting from the drop down list.



5. You can narrow your search to a particular area by selecting a specific status and/or a specific **Ward** from the drop down lists.
6. When you have made your selections, click on the **Search** button.
7. A list of all the applications that match the search will be displayed.
 - To change the direction of the list select Ascending or Descending from the **Direction** drop down list, followed by **Go**.
 - You can re-order the list by reference number, date received, description or status. Select one of these from the **Sort by** drop down list, then click on **Go**.
 - If there a large number of properties in the selected street you can navigate between the results pages either by clicking on **Next** to view the next page or by clicking directly on the page number displayed just above and below the search results.
 - To change the number of results displayed, select from the **Results per page** drop down list, followed by **Go**.

Comments (only available on Planning Applications cases)

1. Click on the **Comments** tab to make a comment on the application (if the application has been decided, you will be advised on the Comments tab that the consultation period has ended and there will not be a comment form)
2. If you have logged in you will see the comment form with your name, address and email automatically added. If these are not correct, click on **update my personal details** and make the appropriate changes. If you are not logged in then the form will be blank so these fields will need to be completed.

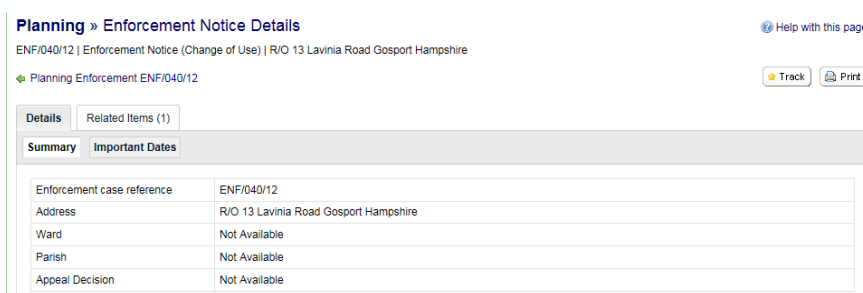
