For example, if 100% of comments were negative to a proposal would that have any impact on the plans or not? How does the public have any confidence that their opinions will ever be taken into account? It is for this reason that I suspect many people don't bother to engage as their voice is never heard, and they have to wait for formal planning applications to object. But because the "master plan" has been formally adopted with the appearance of a consultation process (even though thousands may have objected), any future objections will be meaningless. Secondly it occurs to me that the style, format and content of the material makes it nearly impossible for the general public, untrained in such matters, to decipher and comprehend the real and potential impact of the content. It should be the responsibility of the Borough Council to create simplified versions that explain clearly the context and ramifications if the proposals are adopted. Finally, the Council should commission truly independent surveys to establish how widely the documents have actually been disseminated and understood by the public and publish the results.</p>
