Locally there is a perception and cynicism about local development being a "done deal" by the time it is presented to the public, as was the case with the recent HCC BRT phase 2 exhibition.

It would be good to see more Planning for Real style interactive workshops where community members can get involved and feel genuinely engaged in influencing the process. If such approaches had been taken with rigor developments including the BRT + Brockley St Gate then ~~they would have been~~ designs would have taken greater account of people's natural desires and better incorporated safe, quick + convenient walking + cycling routes.

Greater Manchester Combined Authority has undertaken area wide active planning with residents to help develop the new 'bee lines' active travel network which will reduce congestion within communities + improve walking + cycling networks to improve air quality, health + economic growth. Through a joined up community led approach they've succeeded in attracting significant funding to deliver this plan. PUSH / TFSH + LEP's could support + fund a similar cross boundaries approach to encourage greater genuine community consultation. It would also be good to see Area Action Plans / Neighbourhood Plans + / or the 'Town Team' restructured to facilitate direct community engagement.
