This is a follow-up to my earlier comments about GBC being amenable to allowing parking in Brewhouse Square. Having read through the draft Gosport Waterfront and Town Centre SPD there is much to be commended about your efforts to put a cohesive plan together which regenerates the area and creates an attractive townscape. My concern is the risk that you allow a quality open space to be become an unattractive feature: The document refers to the "establishment of a cultural square in the town centre". An admirable objective which is not consistent with the statement that you "would be amenable to the provision of access to, and parking in Brewhouse Square". Brewhouse Square is slowly but steadily attracting more pedestrian traffic, thus becoming a cultural space, and allowing for parking would be counter-productive to the integrity of the Square. Permitting in the Square will restrict the opportunities for residents and visitors to enjoy the attractive heritage and harbourside features of Brewhouse Square. Permitting parking in the Square runs contrary to your objective to create a healthier town. Parking in existing parking areas requires only a short walk to Royal Clarence Yard – a heathy activity for all. Isn't that a desirable outcome? Parking in the Square is a safety risk for residents and visitors. It is at present a safe place for families and children to navigate without the danger of vehicle traffic. Mums and toddlers use the Square for pedestrian access to the Wendy House unit in RCX. Parking in the Square will not ensure the public realm is enhanced (your strategy, page 23). Allowing car parking here will have a negative impact in an area of soft trees and soft landscaping. Parking in the Square will be a further limit on pedestrian accessibility to RCX. Your document refers to an existing over-supply of parking spaces (page 34). It also states the desire to retain key open spaces, and to encourage more people to walk into the town centre.
